STATUS
CONFERENCE
REPORT

On July 19, 2004, a telephone status conference was held in Salem, Oregon. Representatives from Staff, Verizon, Central Lincoln Public Utility District (CLPUD), Portland General Electric Company, and the Oregon Cable Telecommunications Association filed appearances.

In UM 1087, CLPUD stated that it had sent documents to Verizon to comply with Order No. 04-379. Verizon stated that it had not yet received the documents. The parties asserted that they would work together to ensure that the documents were received.

The parties agreed to a hearing in UM 1087 to be held October 6, 7, and 8, 2004, in Salem, Oregon. The hearing will be held in the Main Hearing Room.

In UM 1096, the parties stated that they were still working towards negotiating a settlement. The parties are to report by Wednesday, July 28, 2004, whether they have settled the docket. If they have not reached an agreement, they are to propose a testimony schedule that will prepare for a hearing in this case to be held the week of October 11-15, 2004, in Salem, Oregon.

Three business days before each hearing, parties should submit a list of witnesses, how long each examination is to take, and any special scheduling requests, in order to facilitate scheduling of the hearing.
