The Opening Brief of Staff addressed the issue of phony income taxes in a way that avoided our actual proposed conditions.

The additional \$15 million per year of what Staff refers to as "tax benefit" (actually tax detriment to ratepayers and government) can be avoided by either of two URP-proposed conditions:

- A. The Commission should recognize the "double leveraged" capital structure proposed by the Applicants for PGE.
- B. The Commission should require PGE not to charge ratepayers for federal and/or state and/or local income taxes, and all other taxes, that PGE does not actually pay to government.

Recognizing the "double leveraged" capital structure, as proposed in the Testimony of Daniel W. Meek, would itself eliminate the \$15 million annual charges of phony income taxes to ratepayers by recognizing the new \$707 million in debt as debt of the utility. Staff apparently proposes to have this debt ignored in determining PGE's revenue requirement, which will inevitably result in the imposition of the

phony income taxes on ratepayers.
