DISPOSITION: HEARING CANCELED FOR OCTOBER 19, 2004.
HEARING TO BEGIN OCTOBER 20, 2004.

Witnesses Kelvin Davis and Carrie Wheeler are scheduled for cross-examination today. Early this morning, ALJ Logan received information that Mr. Meek would not be present at today's hearing. Based on his unavailability, Mr. Meek has waived cross-examination of Mr. Davis. The ALJs also received information that ICNU waived cross-examination of Mr. Davis. We understand that ICNU and Applicants have reached an agreement about the admissibility of cross-examination exhibits and Mr. Davis' deposition. Finally, Staff waived cross-examination of Mr. Davis.

Staff also indicated that its cross-examination of Ms. Wheeler would be very limited, taking approximately five minutes. Because today's hearing would take little time, Staff asked that today's hearing be canceled, and that Ms. Wheeler's cross-examination be moved to tomorrow.

Staff's request is granted. It makes little sense to convene all of these parties for a brief day of hearings. Ms. Wheeler will be cross-examined by Staff on Wednesday. **Hearing will begin at 9:00 am on October 20, 2004.** Mr. McDermott is scheduled to be the first witness, who will testify by telephone.
