DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED

On April 29, 2004, Mr. Daniel Meek filed petitions to intervene on behalf of Katherine Futornick, Michael Caruso, Frank Nelson, Nancy Newell and Friends of the Clackamas River. Mr. Meek represents these individuals and entities solely for the purpose of filing the petitions. If the petitions are granted, each individual will represent him or herself, and Scott Forrester will represent Friends of the Clackamas River. On May 3, 2004, American Rivers filed a petition to intervene.

These individuals and entities have sufficient interest in the proceedings, and their appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. *See* OAR 860-013-0021. Although April 29, 2004 was the deadline for filing petitions to intervene, the Administrative Law Judge has the discretion to grant late-filed petitions.

The petitions to intervene are granted, subject to the filing of timely objections.
