DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR SHORTENED TIME FOR RESPONSE GRANTED

On May 21, 2004, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a motion to prevent Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) from taking the deposition of Peggy Fowler, PGE's President and Chief Executive Officer. ICNU noticed the deposition for June 14, 2004. Because of the short time line, PGE also moved to accelerate the time for response to May 28, 2004, proposing that a ruling could be issued by June 7, 2004. Without ruling on the merits of PGE's motion regarding the deposition of Ms. Fowler, PGE's motion as to the shortened time for response from ICNU is granted.
