DISPOSITION: CONFERENCE CANCELLED

In response to my March 18, 2005 ruling, the Klamath Water Users' Association (KWUA) filed a letter indicating that it has agreed to produce non-privileged documents requested by PacifiCorp in its motion to compel. KWUA also stated that parties agreed that KWUA will produce the documents by noon on Friday, March 25, 2005. Based on this agreement, KWUA believes that the conference scheduled for March 24, 2005 is unnecessary and should be cancelled.

PacifiCorp filed a response asking that the conference be continued rather than cancelled. PacifiCorp indicates that it will review the documents produced and advise me by the end of the day on Friday, March 25 whether the conference is still needed. PacifiCorp believes that continuing the conference until Monday, March 28 will ensure that the issues raised in its motion to compel will become moot or be resolved with sufficient time for PacifiCorp to meet the March 31 deadline for filing a motion for summary disposition.

The conference is cancelled. KWUA shall comply with the terms of its agreement reached by PacifiCorp and provide the requested documents. I decline to continue the conference based on KWUA's assurance that it is willing to cooperate with PacifiCorp and provide the requested documents. I am hopeful that KWUA's production of documents will moot PacifiCorp's motion to compel. However, I ask PacifiCorp to promptly notify me if any issues remain unresolved, and if necessary I will promptly schedule a conference with the parties to address the concerns.
