2	The Applicants have filed this Application pursuant to the provisions of ORS 757.511.		
3	Upon approval of this Application and closing of the proposed transaction, the Applicants will		
4	exercise substantial influence over the policies and actions of Portland General Electric		
5	Company within the meaning of ORS 757.511. As an electric public utility in the state of		
6	Oregon, and being subject to ORS 757.511, PacifiCorp has an interest in the issues raised in this		
7	proceeding, including any approval conditions proposed by the parties or the Commission.		
8	4.		
9	Since 1988, PacifiCorp itself has filed applications with the Commission regarding		
10	changes in ownership, control or corporate structure. In 1988, the Commission approved the		
11	merger of the former PacifiCorp, a Maine corporation, with Utah Power & Light Company		
12	pursuant to ORS 757.480. In 1999, the Commission issued an order authorizing Scottish Power		
13	plc to exercise substantial influence over the policies and actions of PacifiCorp, pursuant to		
14	ORS 757.511. ² In 2001, the Commission granted PacifiCorp Holdings, Inc. authorization under		
15	ORS 757.511 to exercise substantial influence over the policies and actions of PacifiCorp. ³		
16	5.		
17	PacifiCorp has experience with proceedings under ORS 757.511, and its participation in		
18	this proceeding may assist the Commission in resolving the issues before it. PacifiCorp will not		
19	unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceedings. No		
20	other party can adequately represent PacifiCorp's interests in this proceeding.
