The Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (“ICNU”) and Portland General Electric (“PGE”) have reached agreement in principle regarding Schedule 76R, which provides an option to purchase economic replacement power for partial requirements customers. ICNU and PGE are working on completing a stipulation, which will be filed in the above referenced docket.

In the unlikely event that the parties are unable to agree on the terms of the stipulation, ICNU and PGE will notify you by letter.
