


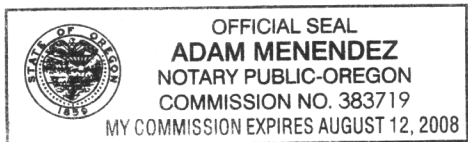

Information about proposed electricity price changes, and how we can help you use electricity wisely.

On March 15, PGE filed a request with the Oregon Public Utility Commission (OPUC) for a general rate revision to increase rates 8.9 percent, or \$143 million annually in 2007. It is the first step in about a ten-month public process.

This price increase covers increased wholesale power and fuel costs, building a new power plant to serve PGE customers and other operating expenses needed to maintain high levels of service and reliability.

PGE meets a growing need by securing our customers' energy future.

Our territory's demand for electricity is growing by about 2 percent annually. For example, PGE added 14,333 new customer accounts in 2005. That's like adding another Oregon City in just one year! Over four years, customer numbers have grown by 6.5 percent.

To meet this growing demand, PGE has a plan to secure our customers' energy future. PGE is building a new super-efficient power plant that is being constructed right now in Columbia County near Clatskanie. We're buying more power from Oregon wind farms, too. Together, this means more energy is on its way to our customers.

We're putting our energy in to helping you save energy.

What's the bottom line for PGE customers?

The proposed price increase is 8.9 percent across all customer types. If our request is approved, Residential customers (Schedule 7) will see an 8.5 percent increase. Business customers (Schedule 32) will see a 10.5 percent increase. Industrial customers (Schedule 83) will see an 8.7 percent increase.

The average PGE residential customer using 900 kilowatt-hours per month will see an increase of \$6.64 in their monthly bill.

You can have a say in the process.

Prices are set for Oregon's investor-owned utilities in an open, transparent process called a rate case. It is conducted by the OPUC and includes significant involvement from customer groups, local governments and other parties. You are welcome to join in the process by sharing your thoughts at public meetings hosted by the OPUC.


