The Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities ("ICNU") files this Notice of Intent to Request an Issue Fund Grant in UE 180, pursuant to OAR § 860-017-0050 and the Intervenor Funding Agreement ("IFA") approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission ("Commission") in Order No. 03-388 (July 2, 2003).

- 1. Portland General Electric Company ("PGE" or the "Company") has filed a request for a general rate increase in the Company's Oregon annual revenues. The Commission will decide on the application in Docket No. UE 180.
- 2. UE 180 is an Eligible Proceeding under the IFA. The IFA defines an Eligible Proceeding as "any Commission proceeding that directly affects one or more of the Participating Public Utilities."
