DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE GRANTED

On June 8, 2006, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) filed a petition to intervene in this proceeding. ORS 756.525(2) provides that the Commission may permit a party to apply to appear and participate in a proceeding “[a]t any time before the final taking of evidence” and must allow the intervention “if the [PUC] determines that such appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues or burden the record.” *See also* OAR 860-012-0001(2).

I find that ICNU has sufficient interest in this proceeding and that its appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. Accordingly, the petition is granted.
