DISPOSITION: MOTION TO AMEND PETITION GRANTED

On July 14, 2006, Oregon Trail Electric Consumers Cooperative, Inc. (Oregon Trail) filed a Petition for Remedy of Pole Attachment Violations, Payment of Sanctions and Rental Fees, and Removal of Pole Attachments (Petition). In the Petition, Oregon Trail requested that the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) order Almega Cable (Almega) to remedy all alleged violations of specified Commission rules, and to pay sanctions and pay past-due rental fees.

On August 1, 2006, Oregon Trail filed a motion to amend its petition. Specifically, Oregon Trail moves to correct an allegation in the petition and update the amounts owed by Almega for alleged violations. Almega did not object to Oregon Trail's motion, and the time for doing so has passed.

The motion to amend the petition, filed by Oregon Trail Electric Consumers Cooperative, Inc., is granted.
