RULING

**DISPOSITION: PARTIES TO FILE NOTICE TO EITHER
TERMINATE OR REACTIVATE DOCKET**

On January 31, 2007, Oregon Trail Electric Consumers Cooperative, Inc. (OTECC) and Almega Cable reported that they stated that they had reached an agreement in the above captioned case. The agreement required Almega Cable to remedy certain pole attachment violations by June 3, 2007, and to pay monies to OTECC for back rent and sanctions by December 31, 2007. The agreement also required OTECC to move for dismissal of this matter within 30 days of confirmation that Almega Cable had fulfilled its duties.

On February 6, 2007, Administrative Law Judge Christina Hayes issued a ruling that suspended the docket until “further notice is submitted by the parties, to either terminate the case or reactivate proceedings.” See ALJ Ruling Feb. 6, 2007. No further document has been filed by any party.

The parties are asked to file a joint status report explaining the status of this proceeding and indicating whether this matter should be terminated or reactivated. The report must be filed by October 31, 2008.
