OAR 860-028-0200 and 860-028-0220. In no way would OJUA's involvement abridge the rights of the parties to pursue litigation through the Commission or other venues; however, the OJUA represents a variety of perspectives in joint pole use, including cable companies and consumer-owned utilities, and I believe they may be of assistance, particularly in the pre-hearing phase of this case.
