PREHEARING CONFERENCE REPORT AND RULING

DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED; SCHEDULE ADOPTED

A prehearing conference was held in this docket on March 16, 2009. Idaho Power Company (Idaho Power); the Citizens Utility Board (CUB); the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA); Stop Idaho Power (SIP); the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE); PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power); the City of Boardman (Boardman); the Commission staff (Staff); and Teresa Ure on behalf of Elizabeth and Tony Ashbeck, Gerald Ashbeck, Ashbeck Brothers and A & A Farms, LLC. At the time of the conference, Petitions to Intervene had been filed by SIP, ODOE, and BPA. The ODOE and BPA Petitions were granted without comment or objection.

The participation of SIP as a party to the proceeding was not opposed; however, in its Comments on the SIP Petition to Intervene, Idaho Power asked that the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) rule on the scope of the issues to be included in the proceeding as requested by SIP. SIP was granted party status, and the ALJ ruled that SIP could file a response to the Idaho Power Comments no later than March 23, 2009. A schedule for the proceeding was adopted as follows:
