Pursuant to Section 7.3 of the Intervenor Funding Agreement ("IFA") adopted by the Oregon Public Utility Commission ("Commission") on July 2, 2003, in Order No. 03-388, the Northwest Industrial Gas Users ("NWIGU") hereby requests partial payment of \$ 5,674.93 from NWIGU's Issue Fund grant in Docket No. UM 1286. In support of this Request for Partial Payment, NWIGU respectfully shows as follows:

- 1. In January 10, 2007, NWIGU filed a Notice of Intent to Request an Issue Fund Grant in this docket. On January 23, 2007, NWIGU submitted a proposed budget in the amount of \$10,725. The Commission approved the Issue Fund Grant and NWIGU's proposed budget on February 27, 2007 in Order No. 07-068.
- 2. NWIGU now requests that the Commission authorize partial payment of its Issue Fund Grant for fees and expenses expended through October 31, 2007. The fees expended by NWIGU for which payment is requested are shown in Confidential Exhibit A. This request for payment satisfies the requirement of IFA Section 7.4 because:
 - Itemized expenses, payees and hourly rates are provided in Exhibit A. IFA Section 7.3
 (a), which has been submitted as a confidential exhibit to the Commission and to NW
 Natural.

Page 1 – REQUEST BY NWIGU FOR PARTIAL PAYMENT

- NWIGU is an active participant in this docket. NWIGU participated in all workshops held through the first phase, has submitted initial comments following the first phase of workshops and will continue to participate in this proceeding in future comment opportunities and workshops as provided by the Commission. Expenses related to these activities from January to October 2007 were reasonably incurred and are directly attributable to the issues and positions pursued on NWIGU's behalf for industrial customers in this proceeding. IFA Section 7.3 (b).
- No conditions were placed on NWIGU's Issue Fund Grant in Order No. 07-068. IFA
 Section 7.4 (c).
