3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many members of ICNU are customers of Portland General Electric Company (“PGE”), as indicated on Attachment A.

4. ICNU has a substantial interest in the impacts of PGE’s application for revised tariffs. The proposed rate change would substantially and directly affect those of ICNU’s members who purchase power from PGE. ICNU requests leave to intervene in this Docket to represent its members who are affected by the proposed rate increase.

5. ICNU represents the interests of many of PGE’s largest customers. ICNU participated in PGE’s most recent general rate case, Docket No. UE 180, as well as numerous other proceedings that affected PGE’s rates. ICNU’s intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues in this proceeding and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay this proceeding.

6. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by any Commission determination made in connection with these proceedings. It is in the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, ICNU respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition to intervene with full party status in this proceeding.

The Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (“ICNU”) files this Notice of Intent to Request an Issue Fund Grant in UE 188, pursuant to OAR § 860-017-0050 and the Intervenor Funding Agreement (“IFA”) approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) in Order No. 03-388 (July 2, 2003).

1. Portland General Electric Company (“PGE” or the “Company”) has filed a request for a general rate increase in the Company's Oregon annual revenues. The Commission will decide on the application in Docket No. UE 188.

2. UE 188 is an Eligible Proceeding under the IFA. The IFA defines an Eligible Proceeding as “any Commission proceeding that directly affects one or more of the Participating Public Utilities.” IFA, Section 1(c). UE 188 will directly affect PGE, which is a Participating Public Utility under Section 1(k) of the IFA. Therefore, an Issue Fund Grant may be made for this proceeding under Section 6.1 the IFA.

3. As required by Section 6.2 of the IFA, this Notice of Intent is being filed at the time ICNU is requesting intervention in UE 188.

4. As required by IFA Section 6.2, this Notice of Intent is being served on each affected Participating Public Utility, all precertified organizations, and all parties identified on the service list from UE 188.

5. ICNU identifies the PGE Issue Fund Account as the account from which ICNU intends to request the Issue Fund Grant.

6. ICNU has been precertified under Sections 5.1 and 5.2 of the IFA and OAR § 860-017-0050(3), as eligible to receive an Issue Fund Grant, by Commission Order No. 03-502, which was entered on August 21, 2003.

7. ICNU requests that the Commission establish a deadline by which ICNU must file a proposed budget with respect to the Issue Fund Grant, as provided in Section 6.3 of the IFA.
