DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE SET

On March 21, 2007, a prehearing conference was held in Salem, Oregon. Portland General Electric Company (PGE), Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU), and Commission Staff (Staff) appeared in person. The Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB) appeared by telephone.

CUB had submitted a notice of intervention. ICNU had submitted a petition to intervene. No party objected to ICNU's petition to intervene. Based on the representations in ICNU's petition, I found that ICNU has sufficient interest in the proceeding and its appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. The petition was granted.

The parties agreed to the following schedule:

Petitions to intervene	April 4, 2007
Settlement conference	May 31, 2007
Reply Testimony – Staff and intervenors	June 20, 2007
Rebuttal Testimony – PGE including AUT update	July 11, 2007
Hearing	August 1, 2007.

CUB also noted that, in its workpapers, PGE submitted data related to items other than Biglow Canyon in its initial filing. CUB stated that if issues other than Biglow Canyon are raised in this proceeding, CUB reserves the right to move for an extension of the schedule.
