RE: UE 189, CAPO and OECA Conditions

In Docket UE 189, PGE committed in coordination with the Community Action Partnership of Oregon (CAPO) and Oregon Energy Coordinators Association (OECA) to develop training materials for Community Action Agencies (CAAs) so that the CAAs would be able to educate low-income customers regarding AMI remote connect functionality.

Remote connect functionality has been delayed since the stipulation and PGE expects that the provision of training materials to the CAAs will now occur by the third quarter of 2010. By timing the development and delivery of the training materials with the implementation of the functionality, CAA's will receive information and training just prior to the implementation of the function and be less likely to then require further training.

PGE discussed this change during the Semi-Annual Agency Meeting on May 12, 2009 and parties were in verbal agreement.
