

3. PGE intends to replace most of its current meters with Advance Metering Infrastructure (“AMI”) and requests certain regulatory treatment of costs associated with AMI. As an electric utility, PacifiCorp is interested in monitoring this proceeding to be

able to assess whether it could affect PacifiCorp's own business decisions regarding metering issues.

4. PacifiCorp's participation in this docket will assist the Commission in resolving the issues. PacifiCorp will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceedings.
