3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many members of ICNU are customers of PGE as indicated on Attachment A.

4. ICNU has a substantial interest in the impacts of PGE's annual adjustment to the Annual Power Cost Update Tariff in Schedule 125. The Commission approved Schedule 125 in Docket No. UE 180, and ICNU fully participated in that proceeding. ICNU was also a participant in the proceedings regarding PGE's annual adjustment to the Resource Valuation Mechanism conducted in 2002 (Docket No. UE 139), 2003 (Docket No. UE 149), 2004 (Docket No. UE 161), 2005 (Docket No. UE 172), and 2006 (Docket No. UE 181). PGE's annual revisions will affect the rates for service that PGE provides to ICNU's members.

5. ICNU represents the interests of many of PGE's largest customers. ICNU's intervention in these proceedings will assist the Commission in resolving the issues in this proceeding and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.

6. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by any Commission determination made in connection with these proceedings. It is in the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, ICNU respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition to intervene with full party status in this proceeding.
