Earlier today Universal Telecom, Inc. ("Universal") filed its Reply Brief in Support of Proposed Order" in the above-captioned docket. That document contained an incorrect footnote 1. Footnote 1 should read as follows:

To the best of Universal's information and belief, Qwest imposed the suspension on or about July 3, 2007. Universal has approximately 25 T-1's that the company would like to disconnect immediately. Given Qwest's assertion that it has disconnected 43% of LIS trunks interconnecting the parties (see note 4, infra) Universal is unable to quantify precisely what additional savings (or, mitigation of "revenue erosion") would result for Qwest if 25 T-1's were disconnected. However, Universal believes there remain opportunities to lower the monthly RUF bills it receives.

Universal's pleading is unchanged in all other respects.
