This amendment makes housekeeping changes to OAR 860-027-0005 by eliminating the requirement that large telecommunications utilities file annual budgets of expenditures with the Public Utility Commission. ORS 759.100 requiring large telecommunications utilities to file annual budgets of expenditures was repealed by Senate Bill 600 during the 2005 legislative session.

The agency requests public comment on whether other options should be considered for achieving the rule's substantive goals while reducing negative economic impact of the rule on business.

## Utilities Required to File Reports Budget of Expenditures

Each energy **and large telecommunications** utility operating within Oregon and having gross operating revenues of \$50,000 or more per annum is required to file with the Commission on or before the first day of November of each year, a copy of its proposed Budget of Expenditures, on forms approved by the Commission.
