9	Comes now the staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (staff) and responds to		
10	Portland General Electric Company's (PGE) "Motion for Approval of a Modified Protective		
11	Order" (Motion). The Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued his Order conditionally granting		
12	the Motion, subject to the timely filing of objections. See Order No. 07-440 (entered October 16,		
13	2007).		
14	Staff does not object to the entry of the Order with the following clarification to		
15	paragraph 9 of the Modified Protective Order (MPO). As written, paragraph 9 prohibits the		
16	parties' sharing of the Confidential Information among qualified persons unless expressly		
17	allowed by the party desiring confidentiality (i.e. PGE in this case) or by order of the presiding		
18	officer. Staff is concerned that such a clause, if broadly applied, would prevent qualified parties,		
19	who have each properly obtained the Confidential Information under the MPO, from discussing		
20	that information with each other (without first obtaining PGE's permission or obtaining approval		
21	from the ALJ). The need for such discussions could arise in the settlement conference setting, or		
22	simply in private telephonic conversations between two or more qualified parties who have each		
23	independently obtained the Confidential Information under the MPO.		
24	Staff counsel has discussed this issue with Richard George, counsel for PGE. Mr.		
25	George stated that it was not PGE's intent to prevent or hinder such discussions between and		
26	among qualified parties and PGE has no objection to such discussions occurring under the

1	circumstances described (i.e. each party to the di-	scussion has independently properly obtained	
2	the Confidential Information under the MPO). A		
3	prevent a qualified party from discussing or distributing Confidential Information with another		
4	qualified party that has not yet obtained the information under the MPO. With this clarification,		
5	which staff requests the ALJ memorialize in a Clarification Order, staff has no objection to the		
6	entry of the MPO.		
7	Finally, staff requests permission to submit further comments on, or objections to, the		
8	MPO should experience with it indicate unanticipated issues.
