Pursuant to ORS § 756.525 and OAR § 860-012-0001, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (“ICNU”) petitions the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (“OPUC” or the “Commission”) to intervene in this proceeding with full party status as described in OAR § 860-011-0035(5). 3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many of ICNU's members are customers of Portland General Electric Company ("PGE"), as shown in Attachment A.

4. ICNU has a substantial interest in PGE's application to open a docket for its Request for Proposals for energy resources. This docket will revolve around the selection of the Independent Evaluator to monitor the Request for Proposals regarding PGE's 2007 Integrated Resource Plan, which was filed in Docket No. LC 43. ICNU is a party to Docket No. LC 43. Any Commission decision in this docket could have a direct and substantial impact on PGE's resource portfolio and therefore the rates that PGE provides to ICNU's members.

5. ICNU represents the interests of a number of large electric customers in the State of Oregon. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.

6. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by any Commission determination made in connection with these proceedings. It is in the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, ICNU respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition to intervene with full party status in this proceeding.
