Avista Files for Natural Gas Rate Changes

On Oct. 15, 2007, Avista filed two separate requests with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (PUC) seeking changes in natural gas rates. The first filing is a purchased gas cost adjustment (PGA) which is filed annually to reflect changes in the cost of natural gas purchased by Avista to serve customers' needs. The PGA filing reflects an average natural gas price decrease of 1.7 percent, to be effective Nov. 1, 2007. The second filings is a general (non gas-cost related) rate request seeking a 2.3 percent increase. The PUC has up to 10 months to make a determination on the general rate request.

Purchase Gas Cost Adjustment

The PGA decrease reflects lower wholesale natural gas prices through September of this year compared to the same period last year. If the decrease is approved by the PUC, a residential customer using an average of 51 therms of natural gas per month could expect to see a \$1.09 decrease, or 1.4 percent, for a revised total monthly bill of \$77.82 beginning Nov. 1. Most commercial customers will see a decrease of 1.6 percent, while industrial customers will see a slightly higher decrease.

General Rate Filing

The general rate filing reflects changes in costs other than the cost of the natural gas. The requested general increase of 2.3 percent, or \$2.97 million annually, is driven by higher costs associated with expanding and maintaining the company's natural gas distribution system. Avista's last general rate increase was in October 2003.

The proposed increase for a residential customer using an average of 51 therms of natural gas per month is \$2.02 per month, or 2.6 percent, for an average monthly bill of \$79.84. The proposed increase for most commercial and industrial customers is between 1 and 2 percent.

The PUC has the authority to determine how much, if any, of the proposed general increase is granted. The PUC has up to 10 months to review the general rate filing.

Avista's continued commitment to customers includes support for LIRAP, an energy assistance program similar to the Federal and State-sponsored LIHEAP program; Project Share, a fuel-blind energy assistance program; CARES, a program assisting customers facing challenges in paying their bills. Avista also offers level payment plans and payment arrangements. Avista also offers a number of programs to help customers manage their energy usage, as well as energy efficiency rebates and incentive programs for residential, commercial and industrial customers.
