NORTHWEST PIPELINE GP'S REQUEST TO WITHDRAW ITS APPLICATION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR REHEARING OF ORDER NO. 08-107 AND PETITION FOR A COMMISSION INVESTIGATION

Northwest Pipeline GP ("Northwest Pipeline") hereby files this Request to Withdraw its Application for Reconsideration or Rehearing of Order No. 08-107 and Petition for Commission Investigation that was filed on February 22, 2008 (the "Rehearing Application").

On November 1, 2007, Northwest Natural ("NW Natural") filed an application for affiliated interest agreements between NW Natural and Palomar Gas Transmission, LLC. A Staff Report supporting of the application was submitted to the Commission on January 2, 2008, and the Commission approved the application on January 28, 2008, in Order No. 08-107.

Since filing its Rehearing Application, Northwest Pipeline has been in discussions with NW Natural regarding this proceeding. Northwest Pipeline has determined that this proceeding may not be the most effective forum for resolving the issues addressed in the Rehearing Application. NW Natural and Northwest Pipeline recognize that NW Natural's interest and support of the Palomar Gas Transmission pipeline is not attributable to NW Natural's assessment of Northwest Pipeline's performance. Northwest Pipeline has confirmed with NW Natural that it does not oppose the withdrawal of the Rehearing Application.

Page 1 - NORTHWEST PIPELINE GP'S REQUEST TO WITHDRAW ITS APPLICATION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR REHEARING OF ORDER NO. 08-107 AND PETITION FOR A COMMISSION INVESTIGATION
