DISPOSITION: REQUEST GRANTED.

On October 24, 2008, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB) filed its Opening Brief in this proceeding; it was 55 pages long and did not have its complete address on the face of the pleading.

On October 28, 2008, CUB filed a Request to Allow Brief in Excess of Fifty Pages and without Complete Address. CUB notes that the Commission's website specifies that no brief should exceed 50 pages without the permission of the Administrative Law Judge. CUB also notes the ORCP Rule 17A requirement that the party's complete address appear on the face of the pleading.

In support of its Motion, CUB asserts that all of the other parties are familiar with its address and that no prejudice has been caused to the other parties or the Commission by the excess length of its brief.

I find that CUB has shown good cause for granting the Request and that it will not unduly delay the proceedings or burden the record.

**RULING**

The Request is GRANTED.
