

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

1           PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power ("PacifiCorp" or "Company") hereby submits this  
2           amended request to the Public Utility Commission of Oregon ("Commission") requesting  
3           acknowledgment of the revised final shortlist of bidders in PacifiCorp's Request for  
4           Proposals for Renewable Electric Resources ("2008R-1 RFP").

5           In support of this Request, PacifiCorp states as follows:

6           1.       This Amended Request is filed pursuant to Order No. 06-446, which  
7           allows a utility the opportunity to request the Commission to acknowledge the utility's  
8           selection of its final shortlist of RFP resources. *See* Order No. 06-446 at p.14.

22 Final Shortlist, attached as Appendices A, B and C, respectively.


23 6. The Company intends to refine its analysis of the Final Shortlist bids to  
24 address localized issues, to include third party expert review of bids’ [REDACTED]  
25 and proposed technology, to assess bid-specific transmission impacts, and to negotiate

1 with Final Shortlist bidders for the lowest price and acceptable terms before selecting a  
2 potential resource from the Final Shortlist.

3 7. The Company hereby incorporates by reference the Request for  
4 Acknowledgment, and the rationale for selection of the Final Shortlist contained therein.  
5 The removal of Bid ■ from the Final Shortlist as described herein does not alter or  
6 change the underlying justifications for selecting the Final Shortlist as set forth in the  
7 Request for Acknowledgment.

8 PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the Commission acknowledge its Final  
9 Shortlist of bidders to the 2008R-1 RFP as revised in this Amended Request.
