DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE*  
GRANTED

On May 6, 2008, CenturyTel of Oregon, Inc. (CenturyTel), filed a motion to admit Thomas J. Moorman *pro hac vice*. CenturyTel states that Sprint Communications Company L.P. does not oppose the motion. CenturyTel also filed the Affidavit of Thomas J. Moorman in Support of Motion for Admission *Pro Hac Vice* and a Certificate of Good Standing for Mr. Moorman from the District of Columbia Court of Appeals. In the affidavit, Mr. Moorman states that he is exempt from the Oregon State Bar Professional Liability Fund plan requirements. Mr. Moorman also states that he will associate with Richard A. Finnigan, an active member of the Oregon State Bar. I find that Mr. Moorman has satisfied the requirements of Oregon Uniform Trial Court Rule 3.170. CenturyTel's motion is therefore granted.
