**PACIFICORP'S MOTION TO SUSPEND
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

9 Pursuant to OAR 860-013-0031, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power ("PacifiCorp" or
10 the "Company") submits this Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule ("Motion") to the
11 Public Utility Commission of Oregon ("Commission").

12 The parties in this proceeding—Commission Staff, PacifiCorp, the Citizens' Utility
13 Board ("CUB"), the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities ("ICNU"), and Sempra
14 Energy Solutions LLC ("Sempra")—have reached an agreement in principal resolving all
15 issues in this docket. The parties expect to file a stipulation memorializing their
16 agreement, along with joint testimony, on or before September 5, 2008.

17 Currently the schedule in this proceeding provides for Staff/Intervenor Surrebuttal
18 Testimony to be filed on September 4, 2008, PacifiCorp Surrebuttal Testimony to be filed
19 on September 15, 2008, a tentative hearing date of September 19, 2008, and a target date
20 for a Commission decision of October 24, 2008.

21 PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the administrative law judge ("ALJ") suspend
22 the procedural schedule in this docket.¹ In the event that the parties are unable to reach a
23 final agreement resolving all issues in this proceeding, the parties will notify the ALJ within
24 10 business days of this filing that the parties are unable to reach agreement and
