RULING

DISPOSITION: DEADLINE ESTABLISHED FOR OBJECTIONS TO PARTIALLY STIPULATED MOTION

On April 22, 2011, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) Staff filed a partially stipulated motion to close this docket. According to Staff, all active parties except the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE), the Renewable Energy Coalition (REC), and Exergy expressly support the motion. ODOE neither supports nor opposes the motion. REC and Exergy have not yet stated a position with respect to the motion.

Commission rules allow a party to file written objections to a stipulation within 15 days after the stipulation is filed. See OAR 860-001-0350(8). I will treat the motion as a stipulation and set a May 9, 2011 deadline for objections. If no party files objections by that date, Staff's motion will be treated as unopposed.
