**DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE AMENDED** 

On December 18, 2009, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a motion seeking an extension of time to submit responses to the Bench Request of November 30, 2009. PGE makes the request on behalf of itself, PacifiCorp, and Idaho Power (Joint Utilities). PGE seeks an extension of time until December 29, 2009, to make a filing, and states that the utilities do not oppose an extension of time for parties to submit a response to the Joint Utilities' filing.

PGE's motion to amend the schedule is granted. The Joint Utilities must file a response to the Bench Request by December 29, 2009. Other parties, including Staff, may file a response to the Joint Utilities' filing by January 25, 2009.
