

4 PacifiCorp, d.b.a. Pacific Power ("Pacific Power" or "the Company"), Defendant
5 in this proceeding, files this Response to Administrative Law Judge Hardie's Bench
6 Request dated October 5, 2009 ("Bench Request"). The Bench Request directs the
7 Company to provide information related to all line extensions installed in the Klamath
8 Falls region within the last three years, in a table format provided in the Bench Request,
9 along with supporting documentation. The Company's first data sample using the criteria
10 set forth in the Bench Request revealed approximately 2200 line extension jobs in the
11 Klamath Falls area within the last three years. Pacific Power discussed this with Judge
12 Hardie, who agreed that parameters to limit the data sample size. The information
13 supplied is confidential and subject to the terms and conditions of the protective order in
14 this proceeding. The Company provides the following information to satisfy the Bench
15 Request:

- 16 ▪ One very important thing to note is that the Rainbow Youth Golf Education
17 Program's ("RYGEP") line extension is a primary metering installation. It is also
18 a non-typical installation for a customer of RYGEP's size. There have been no
19 other primary metering installations in the Klamath Falls area in the last three
20 years. The data provided in this response includes only secondary metering line

1 estimates ranging from \$8000 to \$15,000, overhead installations, and the Klamath
2 Falls cost center. The line extensions included in the sample may vary as to length
3 of “main” or “drop.”
