DISPOSITION: PACIFIC POWER DIRECTED TO SUBMIT ADDITIONAL DATA

During the May 20, 2009, prehearing conference in this matter, the parties discussed the allegations in Rainbow Youth Golf Education Program, Inc.'s (RYGEP) complaint and the scope of the Commission's jurisdiction. During the course of that conference, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power), averred that the Contract Minimum Billing charges in RYGEP's contract were calculated based on Pacific Power's Rule 13 and Pacific Power's Schedule 300. For that reason, RYGEP's request to change specific elements of its Contract Minimum Billing charges was deemed inappropriate.

While Pacific Power provided a number of details about cost in its motion to dismiss, it has become clear that one part of the Contract Minimum Billing calculation cannot clearly be derived from the information previously provided. Under Pacific Power's Rule 13, a Contract Minimum Billing charge is calculated as 80 percent of the Consumer's monthly bill for electric service plus a "Facilities Charge." Pacific Power's Schedule 300 states that a Facilities Charge is either 0.67 percent of installed cost per month for facilities installed at the consumer's expense, or 1.67 percent of installed cost per month for facilities installed at the company's expense.

Pursuant to OAR 860-014-0070, Pacific Power is directed to provide a written calculation of the \$210.55 Facilities Charge included in the Minimum Contract Billing provision of RYGEP's contract, along with documentation (such as invoices or other documentation of cost) supporting that calculation. This information should be filed with the Commission and served on RYGEP by **July 17, 2009**. RYGEP will be given an opportunity to respond to Pacific Power's information. Any such response must be filed by **July 31, 2009**.
