Pursuant to ORS 757.259 and OAR 860-027-0300, Portland General Electric Company ("PGE") hereby requests authorization to defer for later rate-making treatment expenses associated with an increase in FERC federal land use charges. PGE may seek amortization of the deferred amount in a future Commission proceeding. In support of this Application, PGE states:

- 1. PGE is a public utility in the state of Oregon and its rates, services and accounting practices are subject to the regulation of the Oregon Public Utility Commission ("Commission").
- 2. This application is filed pursuant to ORS 757.259, which allows the Commission, upon application, to authorize deferral of certain items for later incorporation in rates.

I. OAR 860-027-0300(3) Requirements

The following is provided pursuant to OAR 860-027-0300(3).

A. Background

On February 17, 2009, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) issued a "Final

rule; update of Federal land use fees," Docket No. RM09-6-000. In this ruling, FERC updated the land

fees based on the United States Forest Service schedule of fees for the use of linear rights-of-way on

government land. The fiscal year for FERC is October 1, 2008 to September 30, 2009, and the new fee

schedule is retroactive to October 1, 2008.

B. Reasons for Deferral

PGE incurs various FERC fees, such as administrative fees, transmission fees, and land use

fees. PGE received notice that FERC is increasing its annual fees for use of federal lands by

approximately \$1.2 million annually over the previous level. Notice of this increase occurred

subsequent to the close of the UE 197 general rate proceeding. Because this is a required cost increase

for which PGE has no managerial discretion, we seek this deferral pursuant to ORS 757.259(2)(e).

C. Proposed Accounting

PGE proposes to record the deferred amount as a regulatory asset in FERC account 182.3,

Other Regulatory Assets, with credits to FERC account 567, Rents (Hydraulic Power Generation) and

FERC account 540, Rents (transmission system).

D. Estimate of Amounts

PGE estimates the amount subject to the deferral would be approximately \$1.2 million on an

annual basis.

E. Notice

A copy of the notice of application for deferred accounting treatment and a list of persons served with the notice are attached to the Application as Attachment A.

II. Conclusion

For the reasons stated above, PGE requests permission to defer expenses associated with an increase in FERC land fees as described herein from the date of this Application.
