RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED

By motion filed August 3, 2009, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) asks that the procedural schedule in the above proceeding be suspended for ten days. In support of its motion, PGE states that the other parties (Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, and the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon) agree in principle of the significant terms of a settlement of this matter. PGE adds that one issue has arisen that "requires a little additional time for discussion among the parties." PGE requests that the schedule be suspended, to allow the parties to agree to the terms of a Stipulation to be submitted to the Commission. PGE states that all parties support its motion.

PGE has shown good cause for the suspension of the procedural schedule in this matter. The procedural schedule is vacated. In the event that the parties are not able to agree to a settlement, or not able to agree to a complete settlement, any party may file a motion to reinstate a procedural schedule.
