


RULING

DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED

On April 16, 2009, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a petition to intervene in this docket. On April 22, 2009, Klamath Water Users Association (KWUA) filed a petition to intervene. The period to contest these petitions has passed, and no objections were received. Upon review of the petitions to intervene, we find that PGE and KWUA have sufficient interest in the proceeding and that their appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. *See* OAR 860-012-0001. Accordingly, the petitions to intervene are granted.
