I. INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to the schedule adopted in this proceeding, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon ("CUB") submits its proposed information requests. Avista's UG 186 filing lacks testimony and exhibits which should have been included with its original filing in order to enable a complete review of the case. In order to create a more comprehensive evidentiary record, CUB requests that the presiding Administrative Law Judges order Avista to provide supplemental testimony and exhibits on the items listed in this information request.

The filing of proposed information requests is a new process in this rate case. This request for supplemental testimony should not interfere with timely responses to CUB's data requests. Due to the short amount of time until CUB's opening testimony is due, CUB respectfully requests that the ALJs include in their ruling clarification that Avista is required to adhere to the data response time frames as outlined in the prehearing conference memo with the understanding that supplemental testimony is not a substitute

for data responses, and that data responses are not a substitute for the requested testimony.
