PREHEARING CONFERENCE

**DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE ADOPTED**

A prehearing conference was held in the above captioned proceeding on August 5, 2009. Appearing at the conference were Douglas C. Tingey on behalf of Portland General Electric Company (PGE); and Ed Durrenberger on behalf of the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff). S. Bradley Van Cleve on behalf of the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU); and G. Catriona McCracken on behalf of the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB) participated by telephone.

Following an off-the-record discussion, the parties agreed to the following schedule:

In their discussion, the parties also agreed to dates for a workshop and settlement conference.<sup>2</sup>

The schedule is reasonable and is ADOPTED.

<sup>2</sup> Staff will provide notice to the Parties of any workshops and settlement conferences. The details do not require Commission approval.

CUB filed its Notice of Intervention pursuant to ORS 774.180 on July 21, 2009. ICNU filed a Petition to Intervene on August 4, 2009. ICNU's petition is granted, pending the filing of a timely protest.
