Application for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier.

DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR SCHEDULING CONFERENCE GRANTED

On August 16, 2010, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB) filed a motion requesting that a scheduling conference be convened to address further amendment of the procedural schedule in this docket. CUB explains that on August 13, 2010, TracFone Wireless, Inc. (TracFone) notified this Commission of its intention to expand its Safelink Wireless© Lifeline for both new and current customers. In the notice, TracFone states that, upon designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) in Oregon, it will give its Oregon Lifeline customers the options to select three different monthly plans. CUB contends that TracFone's explanation of services adds significant new facts to this proceeding that require additional time for discovery and testimony. CUB adds that Commission Staff supports the motion.

TracFone opposes CUB's request. TracFone contends that its announcement of expanded service offerings does not require additional discovery or further delay in the proceeding. TracFones states that the announced changes are quite straightforward, and opposes any further delay in these proceedings. TracFone also states that, even if CUB needs formal discovery on these new offerings, it does not need a revision to the schedule to allow it to present evidence on August 23, 2010. TracFone explains that the testimony due on August 23 allows CUB to respond only to the testimony of other parties; it does not allow CUB to further respond to TracFone's opening testimony.

CUB's motion to convene a scheduling conference is granted. A telephone conference will be held on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>August 24, 2010</u>, at 11 a.m. Notice of the conference is attached to this ruling.

In granting CUB's motion, I clarify that the August 23 date for Reply Testimony has not been suspended. Parties may file testimony to address the Parties'

Responsive Testimony filed on August 3. I also affirm the Commission's intention to process this case as expeditiously as possible. Given TracFone's recent proposed change to its service offerings, however, all parties—including TracFone and CUB—must have the opportunity to address the impact of such changes on TracFone's application for ETC certification in Oregon. The purpose of the scheduling conference will be to address what additional procedures are necessary to ensure an adequately developed record for the Commission's decision.

Following the telephone conference, I will ask CUB and TracFone to remain on the line so I can discuss and clarify the parties' outstanding motions to compel discovery in the hopes of facilitating a resolution to those conflicts.
