- 3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many members of ICNU are customers of Portland General Electric ("PGE"), as indicated on Attachment A.
- 4. ICNU has a substantial interest in the Commission's investigation to determine if PGE's rate revision has been consistent with the methodologies and calculations required by Order No. 05-584. The proposed order could change and directly affect those of ICNU's members who purchase power from, or sell power as qualifying facilities to PGE. ICNU requests leave to intervene in this Docket to represent its members who are affected by the proposed investigation.
- 5. ICNU represents the interests of many of PGE's largest customers. ICNU has participated in numerous other proceedings that affected PGE's rates, including its avoided cost rates. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by any Commission determination made in connection with these proceedings. It is in the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, ICNU respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition to intervene with full party status in this proceeding.
