Application for an Order Approving Transaction, and Request for Expedited Consideration. PREHEARING CONFERENCE REPORT

On October 6, 2009, a prehearing conference was held in this docket. The primary purposes of the conference were to identify the parties to the proceeding and to set a procedural schedule.

Appearances

Appearances were entered as follows: Mike Weirich on behalf of Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission); Dave Gabica on behalf of Malheur Home Telephone Company (Malheur); Alex Duarte and Mark Reynolds on behalf of Qwest Corporation (Qwest); and Bob Jenks on behalf of the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB).

Intervention

On September 17, 2009, Qwest filed a petition to intervene. The period for objection has passed, and no objections were filed. Qwest has sufficient interest in the proceeding and its appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. See OAR 860-012-0001. Qwest's petition to intervene is granted.

On October 6, 2009, CUB filed a notice of intervention in this docket. Pursuant to ORS 774.180, CUB may intervene in Commission proceedings as of right. CUB's intervention is noted.

Consolidation with Docket UA 149

Docket UA 149 is a joint application of Qwest and Malheur for an order unallocating and transferring rights to allocated territory from Malheur to Qwest. Since dockets UM 1451 and UA 149 concern the same underlying transaction, the parties at the prehearing conference proposed consolidating the dockets in order simplify the process and address any overlapping issues. The parties' request to consolidate the dockets is granted. The procedural schedule below will apply to both dockets.
