Request to Make Presentation at May 25, 2010 Public Meeting

Several intervenors have asked that they be allowed to make a presentation at the May 25, 2010 Public Utility Commission of Oregon's Public Meeting in Salem. As I noted previously, the Commission's public meetings are open to members of the public. Because the May 25, 2010 meeting is a general public meeting, public comments on this docket will be limited to the time remaining after regular agenda items have been addressed.

Request for Portland Public Meeting

The Commission will hold a public meeting in this docket in Portland, Oregon, on June 23, 2010 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. I will issue a memorandum with the location before the meeting. Members of the public will have the opportunity to comment on Portland General Electric Company's 2009 Integrated Resource Plan, subject to time restrictions to ensure broad participation.
