DISPOSITION: REQUEST FOR BOARDMAN PUBLIC MEETING
GRANTED; REQUESTS FOR HOOD RIVER PUBLIC
MEETING AND FOR SURVEYOR DENIED

At a prehearing conference on July 1, 2010, parties to this docket made three requests.

First, the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 125 (IBEW) requested that the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) hold a public meeting in Boardman, Oregon, so that citizens of Eastern Oregon, particularly those who live in Boardman, could participate in the public comment process in person. In a memorandum issued on June 10, 2010, it was ordered that all remaining meetings in this docket would be held in Salem. However, given the level of interest in this proceeding, the Commissioners have agreed to hold one additional public comment meeting. IBEW's request to hold a public comment meeting in Boardman is granted. The Commission will hold a public meeting as follows:

The Commissioners will attend the meeting. At the meeting, members of the public will have the opportunity to offer comment on PGE's Integrated Resource Plan for the record.

Second, the Sierra Club, Friends of the Columbia Gorge, Northwest Environmental Defense Center, and Columbia Riverkeeper ("Intervenors") requested that if the Commission held a public meeting in Boardman, that it also hold a public meeting in Hood River, Oregon. Intervenors' request for a public meeting in Hood River is denied.

Third, the NW Energy Coalition requested that an independent surveyor conduct a market study to determine if power sources are available to replace the power that would be lost when the Boardman coal plant closes. Commission Staff and PGE both oppose the request. NW Energy Coalition's request is denied.
