DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE GRANTED UPON
EXPIRATION OF EXPEDITED PERIOD TO OBJECT

On April 8, 2011, Smart Grid Oregon (SGO) filed a motion for late intervention and requested expedited treatment. SGO originally filed a petition to intervene, along with closing comments, in this docket on March 31, 2011. SGO filed again, to correct a procedural error and to provide additional information.

SGO states that it monitored the docket and submitted closing comments that do not open new issues of fact. SGO also asserts that the organization's closing comments do not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record or delay the proceeding.

The period for objection to SGO's petition is expedited to end by the close of business on April 15, 2011. Should no party object to SGO's petition, the petition will be granted.
