MEMORANDUM

DISPOSITION: PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE ADOPTED

On May 24, 2010, a prehearing conference was held in the above-captioned docket in order to set a procedural schedule. Appearances were entered by Portland General Electric Company (PGE), PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power), NW Energy Coalition, ECotality, Inc., the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, and the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff).

Prior to the conference, NW Energy Coalition, PGE, and Pacific Power filed petitions to intervene. I find that NW Energy Coalition, PGE, and Pacific Power have sufficient interest in the proceeding and that their appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. *See* OAR 860-012-0001. The petitions are granted.

During the prehearing conference, the parties agreed to the following procedural schedule, which was adopted:


