RULING


DISPOSITION: PROCEEDINGS FURTHER SUSPENDED

On February 25, 2013, I granted a motion to continue to hold the docket in abeyance and ordered the parties to file a status report with the Commission before close of business on April 1, 2013.

On April 1, 2013, CenturyLink filed a status report on behalf of all of the parties indicating that they had reached an agreement in principle and were working to reduce that agreement to a written stipulation. The parties ask that the docket continue to be held in abeyance pending the filing of settlement documents.

The request is granted. The proceedings are suspended until the parties submit settlement documents or file a status report no later than April 15, 2013, whichever occurs first.
