DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE GRANTED; PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE ADOPTED

A prehearing conference in this docket was held on September 24, 2012. In attendance, either in person or by phone, were the Oregon Telecommunications Association (OTA), GVNW Consulting, Inc.; Comcast Phone of Oregon LLC (Comcast); tw telecom of oregon llc (tw telecom); Warm Springs Telecom; CenturyLink; Verizon; and Tracer.

At the conference, the administrative law judge (ALJ) addressed a pending petition and pending motion. First, noting the absence of any objections thereto, the ALJ granted the Petition to Intervene filed by tw telecom. The ALJ next addressed the Motion to Adopt Procedural Schedule, Issue Standard Protective Order and Cancel Prehearing Conference filed jointly by OTA, Comcast, tw telecom, and the Commission Staff. The portion of the motion to cancel the prehearing conference was denied. The procedural schedule was adopted as follows:
