
Request for Proposals for Capacity Resources.

DISPOSITION: REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION GRANTED

On September 10, 2103, Grays Harbor Energy LLC (Grays Harbor) filed an objection to Portland General Electric Company's (PGE) designation of information as confidential under Protective Order 11-097. Because the designated information relates to a matter the Commission will address at a September 19, 2013 Public Meeting, Grays Harbor requests expedited consideration.

The protective order provides that, within seven days of an objection, "the designating party must either remove the confidential designation or file a written response identifying the legal basis for the claim of confidentiality."¹ Given the limited amount of time before the September 19th Public Meeting, I find good cause to shorten the time for a reply and direct PGE to file any response to this objection by noon on Monday, September 16, 2012.
